A Few Suggestions

Craft stations will need to either be on blankets/tarps on the ground or on card tables that you bring. We'll need crews at each location to welcome the children, engage them in the activities and hand out stickers. We also need volunteers Saturday morning to set up the activities before the festival.

- Rain sticks (We'll bring the materials; we need folks to help the children assemble them.)
- Adults in animal costumes for photo opts (Wear your animal costume! Otherwise we'll rent one for you.)
- Tattoos (the temporary kind, of course! We need a couple of stations.)
- Games (such as Duck-duck-goose)
- Bubbles (of the giant sort – we have a recipe)
- Popsicle stick puppets (to color and assemble)
- Paper plate arks (to go with the puppets)
- Puppet theatre (bring one so the children can act out the story with their puppets)
- Storytellers
- Wandering musicians
- Labyrinth (we have one and need a group to organize an experience)
- Rainbow craft (we've ordered craft sets and need people to help the children assemble them.)
- Paper boats (help kids fold small paper boats – origami?)
- Wading pool races (with the paper boats)
- Face painting
- God's eyes
- Carnival-style games (ring toss, bean bag toss, that sort of thing)
- Balloon animals
- First aid station
