

Dear Partners in Mission,

Greetings to you all from Mongolia where I serve as a Global Ministries missionary. I am thankful for your support which allows my mission service.

As the end of 2014 is approaching, I wish give thanks God and praise Him for His faithfulness to the ministries in Mongolia and thank you for your partnership and love throughout the year. Your sacrificial prayer and financial support for the ministries in Mongolia is God sent.

During the harsh Mongolian winter, all I see is thick clothing and gloves, hats and mufflers around their faces walking on the smog filled and Cold Street in a hurry. I wonder how many of these people are working hard in very difficult circumstances just to survive another day and want to forget the physical and emotional toll and pain by getting drunk. I'm thankful to and praise God that among these people we have raised young Mongolian men and women with God given vision and hope that are hard at work, regardless of circumstances, to honor and glorify God with their lives and share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with other Mongolians. The seeds have been scattered and the growth is taking place by God's grace.

During this past year, I have observed many gracious changes, in and out of churches and individual and group, through various mission programs and ministries. Some of the Mongolian believers have truly grown in their faith in that they have committed to the church and the ministries in sharing the Gospel with the unbelievers. I praise God for His amazing grace and all these fruits truly glorify His name.

At **Chingeltei UMC**, the Good News of Jesus Christ is shared and shown through various ministries, such as the **Children Learning Center (Kindergarten), Street/Homeless People Ministry and the Detention Ministries**. We provide educational,



physical, emotional and spiritual needs through these ministries and give people hope for their lives. The **kindergarten** was closed for nearly two weeks due to electrical problems. This is the first time we had this type of problem during the past five years we have been operating the Kindergarten ministry. We would not have to close the Kindergarten ministry only if we had an emergency generator. **Street and Homeless ministry (See Photo)** is not only feeding but also worship including praise and prayer. It

has been nine years since we started the **Detention ministry at Building 111**. I was struggling with the Detention staff's request to teach them English on Mondays from 9 AM to 10 AM since finding a qualified person for Monday is a very tough. The Detention staff included the policemen, guards, doctors and nurses. God finally answered our prayers as we earnestly prayed to God about this need. A local college professor volunteered because he does not have any classes on Monday morning. Again praise God for His sovereignty! God also opened a door for us to minister to **Gants Khodag Detention**. As such, we have been doing the Bible Study and Worship every Wednesday. We have stored Matthew 25:31 – 46 passage in our hearts as we minister to the detentioners. On 17 December 2014, four of church members, including me, shared the Gospel with 300 prisoners at this prison and provided 300 prepared bags containing food and the Gospel track from Chingeltei UMC. Guards thanked us for our ministry and we even received thank you telephone call from the Superintendent of the Detention. We don't have a photograph since they would not allow us to take photographs.

Damba Church's "Before and After school program" is going very well. Narangerel has received a recommendation to receive a formal training as "Mission Pastor Candidate" and Munkhnaraa is going to graduate from the Methodist Bible School this coming May, 2015. As such, she will start her full-time ministry soon. **The Khonkhor Church** has prepared all the documents for the registration except for one document. We plan to register this church soon so that we could start the ministries. Zurkh uul house church started to rent 1 room of the sports building to accommodate so that adult and children can worship together at one location. On the first week Sunday we are going to rent 2 rooms for worship for adults and children separately. **Batzargal**, one of the Chingeltei church members, moved far away from the city called Takhilt due to personal reasons. The first question I asked her was whether there was a local church in the area so that I may ask the



church to look after this sister and help her continue to grow in her faith. However, I found out that there was no church in the area. As such, I visited Batzargal and asked about starting a house church at her house. Batzargal said yes without any hesitation. Praise and thank God! I came to realize, through this event, God's purpose for having Batzargal move another city: To start a house of worship and prayer in the city where people do not know God; for people who want to go to church to worship

but cannot because the nearest church was too far; and to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with the people who have not yet heard about Jesus Christ. Praise God for His sovereignty! In November, we started a **Takhilt house church** at Batzargal's house. God started to tug at my heart to purchase a property in this area to start a church and provide community service once spring rolls around. For now, **Naranbaatar** who graduated from the Methodist Bible School will minister at this house church. Please pray God's work to be done in the Takhilt city.
