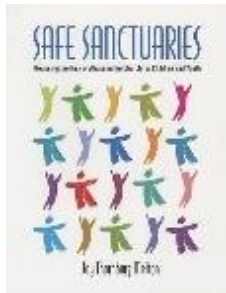
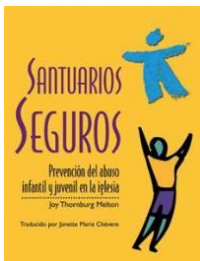

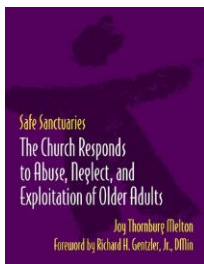
Safe Sanctuaries: Reducing the Risk of Abuse in the Church for Children and Youth by Joy Melton

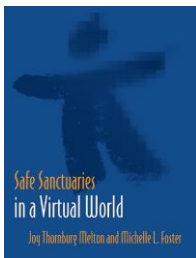

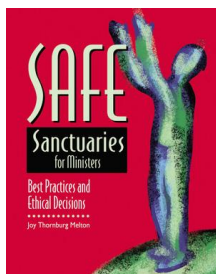
Safe Sanctuaries: The Church Responds to Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation of Older Adults by Joy Melton

This books gets into more specific information for caring for our elders, ministry with older adults. Signs and indicators of abuse, training model and sample forms.



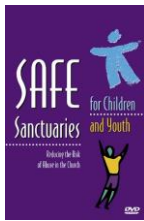
Safe Sanctuaries in a Virtual World by Joy Melton

Safe Sanctuaries definitely crosses over in to the virtual world. This book provides information about copyrights, social media, sample forms and other resources.



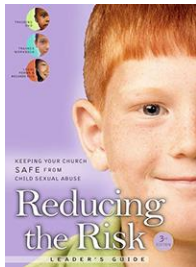
Safe Sanctuaries for Ministers: Reducing the Risk of Abuse in the Church by Joy Melton

This book is geared towards ministers and laity to help understand responsibility and boundaries. Includes hypothetical cases for discussion and discernment and other resources.



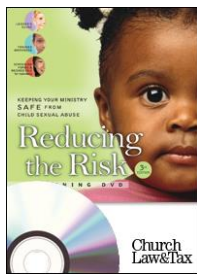
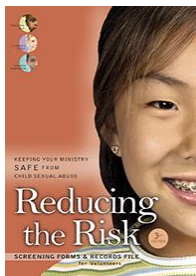
Safe Sanctuaries for Children and Youth (DVD)

This DVD goes along with the Safe Sanctuaries: Reducing the Risk of Abuse in the Church for Children and Youth book described above.



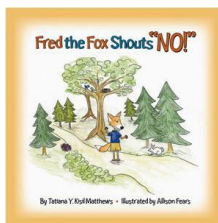
Reducing the Risk by Richard Hammer
